



## REPORTING VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

### Exart. 13 G.D.P.R. N. 679/16 and following provisions

The following information are disclosed to users in implementation of the UE regulation n. 679/16:

- **Identity and contact details of personal data controller: UMBRAMARE s.n.c. di Minervino**, in person of the legal representative P.T., **registered office:** 71019 Vieste (FG) loc. Imbarcatoio – ITALY – Tel/Fax0884-706174; e - mail: umbramarevieste@tiscali.it; p.iva 01271970715.
- **Personal data protection officer:** not mentioned because the data processing is not empowered, ex art. 37 GDPR 679/2016.
- **Purposes of the processing for which the personal data are intended:** monitoring of access areas to business premises for safety reasons and protect property.
- **Legal ground for personal data protection:** legitimate interest for safety reasons and protect property.
- **Personal data recipients or categories of recipients:** data may be transferred to public subjects entitled to submit a request, i.e. judicial and police bodies.
- **Controller intention for transferring personal data to a third country:** it doesn't exist because there is no question of data being transferred to extra UE.
- **Subjects authorised to process personal data:** data may only be processed by the legal representative or technicians authorised to the purpose who may carry on business concerning data processing for the achievement of the objectives.
- **Personal data retention period:** 7 days from the moment images are detected. Upon expiry of this period images will be deleted with the overwriting of new images.
- Interested parties are given notice of the existence of the right to access to images, and the rights, where applicable, governed by art.15 et seq. (UE Reg. 679/16).
- Interested parties are informed about the existence of the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Privacy Guarantor).
- Data processing is necessary for the purposes referred; the refusal of data processing means that the subject is not allowed to access business premises.
- Cameras are properly indicated by warning signs, affixed before the concerning operating zone, in accordance to the Privacy Guarantor legislative act dated 8 April 2010.
